### EHD 200. Research in the University Library. 1 Credit.

Introduction to effective library-based research. Current technologies and traditional methods are emphasized. F,S.

#### EHD 250A. Special Topics. 1-3 Credits.

Specially arranged seminars or courses on contemporary topics not covered by regular departmental offerings. May be initiated by students with approval of dean and departments involved, provided appropriate faculty members are willing. 1 to 3 credits in any one semester; repeatable to 12 credits. Regular grading. Repeatable to 12.00 credits. F,S.

## EHD 250B. Special Topics. 1-3 Credits.

Specially arranged seminars or courses on contemporary topics not covered by regular departmental offerings. May be initiated by students with approval of dean and departments involved, provided appropriate faculty members are willing. 1 to 3 credits in any one semester, repeatable to 12 credits. S/U grading. Repeatable to 12.00 credits. S/U grading. F,S.

## EHD 390A. Special Topics. 1-2 Credits.

May be repeated to 12 credits. Regular grading. Repeatable to 12.00 credits.

## EHD 390B. Special Topics. 1-2 Credits.

May be repeated to 12 credits. S/U grading. Repeatable to 12.00 credits. S/U grading.

#### EHD 495A. Special Problems. 1-3 Credits.

Specially arranged seminars or courses on contemporary topics, having professional orientation and possible prerequisites not covered by regular departmental offerings. May be initiated by the students with approval of dean and department involved, provided appropriate faculty are willing. 1 to 3 credits in any one semester; repeatable to 12 credits. Regular grading, F,S.
