Students in the BS in Public Affairs (new name beginning in Fall 2018) degree program follow a core set of courses that provide a foundation in nonprofit or public administration. Students pursue either the nonprofit track or public administration track to complement the core coursework. Students in the nonprofit track should consider also pursuing a minor in Nonprofit Administration. Students pursuing the public administration track should consider extending their course of study for one year to earn a Master in Public Administration degree (4+1 combined program).
